The YMCA of Central Florida operates enrichment-based programming in 14 middle schools throughout Orange County. At these sites, students are offered a variety of daily clubs from which to choose, including: Athletics, STEM, Culinary Arts, Career Exploration, Service Learning, Performing/Visual Arts, Journalism, Digital Media, and Mentoring. Homework help is also offered each day for all students. Our goal is to meet the needs of our youth through promoting values, reading, wellness, and family engagement. Our program is unique throughout the country and has received numerous awards to date.

The After School Zone has exceeded all contracted outcomes since the start!

1. **Our program participants will attend the school day at a higher rate than non-program participants.**
2. **80% of participating youth will achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher, or show academic improvement.**
3. **80% of participating youth will not have initial or repeat involvement with the Juvenile Justice System.**

The YMCA of Central Florida Summer Zone is funded by a Grant from the Orange County Government.
